We would like to remind parents that children must be in school by 9.00am. The doors open at 8.50am so that the children can go straight into class and start their learning activities.

We ask that parents do not come into school with their child. There are members of staff on both doors who can take messages for the class teachers. Where a meeting is required, please speak to the office to arrange a suitable time to meet with the teacher. We encourage the children to come in without their parents, as this encourages independence. It also ensures the safety of all children as there is limited space in the corridor.

For those arriving after 9.00am, you need to be 'buzzed' into school and you must sign your child in. Miss Crowle will be at the door whenever possible to sign them in and to take them to class. Parents must not take the children to their classrooms as this is a safeguarding issue.

If you are collecting your child early from school or dropping something off that they have forgotten, again we ask that you do not go straight to the classroom but you must go to the school office.

At the end of the day, the gates will be opened at 3.10pm. The children use the playground for outdoor learning throughout the day and we cannot open the gates before that time for safety reasons. Thank you
