Operation Encompass

The school has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between schools and South Wales Police.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has been witness to or involved in any domestic abuse.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school staff, with responsibility for safeguarding, is equipped to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information in confidence that has been shared to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been experienced a domestic abuse incident. We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
