# Free School Meals

If you live in Bridgend County Borough and receive any of the following benefits, you can claim free school meals for your school-aged child: income support

income based jobseeker's allowance

support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 income-related employment and support allowance

child tax credit (but not working tax credit) if your annual income as assessed by tax credits does not exceed £16,190

guarantee element of pension credit

working tax credit 'run-on' (the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for working tax credit) universal credit (not in work)

universal credit (in work) where your award is based on net annual earnings of under £7,400 from your employment or self-employment.

You can make an application on the BCBC website via My Account, a free online service available to all Bridgend County Borough residents.
