- 100%. Your child has the optimum chance to achieve well and take full advantage of every learning opportunity.
- 99% Missing about 2 days approximately 8 lessons.
- 98% Missing about 4 days approximately 16 lessons.
- 97% Missing about 5½ days approximately 22 lessons.
- 96% Missing about 7½ days of school. It will be difficult to catch up on the lost learning from approximately 30 lessons.
